













## **Caterpillar Racers**

This is a ridiculously simple activity, that got a very positive response from the children, even from the older ones. Warning: can get very silly!

## Equipment

A4 coloured paper Straws Black felt tip pen Scissors

## Method

- 1. Cut a strip of paper about 5cm wide, across the width of the paper.
- 2. Fold the strip of paper in half.
- 3. Open the paper out, then fold each end in towards the centre fold.
- 4. Fold each end toward the centre fold again, then make one last fold, so the folded paper is now closed like a book and about 2cm wide.
- 5. Use the scissors to slightly round off each of the corners.
- 6. Gently open out the paper and you should have a caterpillar shape with a raised middle and flat ends.
- 7. Use your felt tip to draw eyes and a smiley mouth on one end.
- 8. Now, find your racecourse these caterpillars move pretty quickly, so make sure it's not too short!
- **9.** Give everyone a straw, line up your caterpillars and use the straw to try to blow them along to the finish line.
